

*Best Practice Guidelines.*

*Best Practice Guidelines* are recommendations for member departments. It is the final decision of each participating department or organization to adopt a Best Practice as policy, procedure, or guideline. The St. Clair County Association of Fire Chief's (SCCAFC) Best Practice Guidelines are selected by a vote of the majority of the membership per the association by-laws.

The Best Practice document may not be used in court or in any other forum against the SCCAFC or against any member individual, other than the use by the individual department or agency adopting the Best Practice as Policy, Procedure, or Guideline.

Failure to adopt a Best Practice Guideline is not proof of a department's failure to comply with a standard of service. Adoption of a best practice is an attempt to meet or exceed the best possible standard of service as researched, developed, and presented for adoption to the SCCAFC.

The decision by the department or agency to adopt a standard of care is a conscious choice of which practices are the best for that agency.
